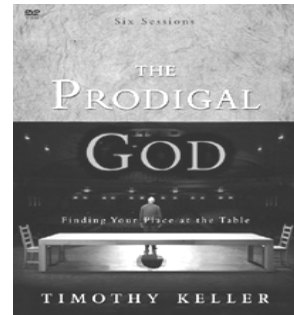


## YOU DON'T WANT TO MISS THIS...
